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Wine: 2016 Zanon Dry Creek Valley Petite Sirah

Availability: Growl; Palmer's; Perfect Pour; Twisted Vine; Village Wine Shop & Bistro; Wine Bistro Lane Avenue; Weiland's; and Giant Eagle stores in Dublin, Grandview Heights, Grove City, Polaris, Powell, Pickerington, and Upper Arlington

Aroma: attractive plum and cherry notes

Flavor: tannin-rich, concentrated cane-fruit flavors; very deep, purple-tinged color.

Notes: Made entirely from one of California's lesser-known grapes (not to be confused with the Syrah grape that originated in France's northern Rhone valley), this is a powerful wine that should easily take on holiday foods ranging from rare roast beef to old-time plum pudding. Consider buying a case to take advantage of its aging potential.
