Wine Review: 2018 Zanon Dry Creek Valley Sauvignon Blanc

- **Wine:** 2018 Zanon Dry Creek Valley Sauvignon Blanc
- **Price:** \$15.99
- **Aroma:** Crisp-yet-rich nose; tropical fruit
- **Flavor:** Citrusy, including grapefruit; refreshing acidity; long finish
- **Notes:** This is the first white wine offering from local wine entrepreneur Scott Zanon, who has built a following for his balanced Dry Creek Valley Zinfandels. Also sourced from Dry Creek Valley grapes, this Sauvignon Blanc sees no oak or other wood. Zanon also avoids malolactic fermentation in his efforts to preserve the natural tartness of the grapes. This wine's refreshing quality is superior to that of recent releases from prominent Dry Creek producers.
