### Wine Review: 2018 Zanon Dry Creek Valley Chardonnay

- **Wine:** 2018 Zanon Dry Creek Valley Chardonnay
- **Price:** \$16.99
- **Aroma:** Nice combination of floral and mineral notes
- **Flavor:** Bracingly refreshing acid balance supports citrusy peach and apricot, with a very light touch of oak
- **Notes:** This is the first chardonnay-based wine from Columbus wine impresario Scott Zanon, who is not a fan of the overblown-style of winemaking. This versatile dry white will play well with Asian foods, in addition to seafood or cream pastas and risottos. Also a good match for well-ripened soft cheeses.
