Wine Review: 2018 Zanon Dry Creek Valley Cabernet Sauvignon

- **Wine:** 2018 Zanon Dry Creek Valley Cabernet Sauvignon
- **Price:** \$24.99
- **Aroma:** Complex scents of can fruits, blueberry and well integrated American and French oak
- **Flavor:** Intensely flavorful with fresh and dried berries, cocoa, with hints of leather and cedar
- **Notes:** This is Columbus wine entrepreneur Scott Zanon's first venture into Cabernet Sauvignon. According to Zanon, it includes all five traditional Bordeaux grapes (Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Cabernet Franc, Petite Verdot, and Malbec), contributing to the many layers of tastes of this darkly colored, bold wine.
